

The Coach Reece Morgan Community Scholarship Application

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANTS

General Information

The Coach Reece Morgan Community Scholarship is awarded to one or more graduating Quad City high school seniors who have served as role models in the community and who have worked hard to achieve academic success. This grant is named in honor of Coach Reece Morgan, a man who spent his life assisting area youth in reaching their dreams and who strongly encouraged students to challenge themselves academically and to pursue higher education. The number of recipients each year and the scholarship amount is determined by the QC United scholarship committee.

Scholarship applicants must adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Be a graduating high school student in the Quad Cities.
2. Demonstrate community leadership within and outside the school setting.
3. Have a 2.5 cumulative grade point average, or equivalent, on a 4-point scale.
4. Attach copy of transcript
5. Submit the following information in typed form, with the designated headings and in the order listed:
 - a. **Application Face Sheet and Objective Criteria Page**
 - b. **List of Extracurricular Activities** (this includes participation in any sports, music, drama activities, clubs and/or organizations. Show years of involvement and also list any offices held.)
 - c. **List all Honors and Awards**
 - d. **List of Community Activities** (includes community service work, community volunteerism)
 - e. **List of Work Activities**
 - f. **Essay** (one hundred fifty word minimum), include ALL of the following:
 - Why is community service important?
 - What have you gained from Community Service as an individual (this can include what you experienced as a recipient of some type of assistance, what were your experiences as a person who assisted others or both)?
 - How have your experiences with Community Service impacted your future plans?
6. **Submit completed scholarship, along with required documents, by April 30th, 2011.**

Evaluation Procedure

Completed applications that meet all of the above guidelines, should be mailed to: QC United P.O. Box 1388

Bettendorf, Iowa 52722. These scholarships will be reviewed by the QC United Scholarship Committee using the following criteria:

- I. 20% Grade point average
- II. 15% Student's curriculum
- III. 15% Financial Need
- IV. 10% Extracurricular/Work
- VII 25% Community Service
- VIII. 15% Essay

The students will be rated using the above criteria. Upon completion of the evaluation process, participating students will be informed of their status via mail regarding this scholarship application. .
