



Food Vendor and/or Chef Demonstration Application Form

Food vendors and Chefs from the Quad City area who offer a variety of ethnic and regional cuisine are invited to participate in Unity Fest International held at the Putnam Museum on September 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> in Davenport, Iowa. The purpose of providing this event is to educate the public about different cultures and to increase appreciation for the wonderful edible gifts each group brings to the table.

Vendor Information:

- \* The International Food Court will be open at the Putnam Museum throughout the day on Sunday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, operating from noon until 5pm. There will be many ethnicities/countries represented but no duplication of offerings.
\*Vendors will be located on the West side of the Putnam Museum under a large tent with direct access to the main floor of the Putnam where the main stage performances will be occurring. (a large utility garage-like door will be open from the main floor to the International Food Court)
\*The only cost to vendors is the Temporary License fee charged by the Scott County Health Department which is \$33.50 (the License Application is attached). Vendors are responsible for obtaining their own license and this must be completed three weeks prior to the event. All proceeds from food sold will stay with the vendors.
\*Electricity (provided by Sutton Electric), water and ice will be available.
\*Tables and chairs are provided. (up to three 8 ft tables will be available)
\*Vendors can begin setting up at 8am on Sunday morning and must be ready to serve food by noon.
\*Vendors can provide up to three offerings which must be pre-approved by the Unity Fest Committee.
\*No sodas or bottled water (this will be sold by the Putnam Museum)
